### Solo Repertoire:

- The complete first movement, with cadenza, of either Mozart's 4th or 5th Violin Concerto

AND

- The exposition of the first movement of a major romantic violin concerto

- 2. Mendelssohn: "Scherzo" from A Midsummer Night's Dream, Op. 61 (Kalmus A1710)**  
Eight measures before Rehearsal **A** through seven after reh. **D** (Measure 17 through m. 99)
- 3. W.A. Mozart: Symphony No. 39 in E-flat Major, K. 543 (Bärenreiter BA 4723)**  
Movement I: Measure 1 through the downbeat of m. 14  
Movement II: Measure 1 through m. 27 (no repeats)  
Movement IV: Measure 1 through m. 78
- 4. R. Schumann: Symphony No. 2 in C Major, Op. 61 (Breitkopf 2339)**  
Movement II: Measure 1 through the downbeat of m. 97 (with repeats)  
Movement II: Coda (Measure 361 through m. 397)
- 5. R. Strauss: Don Juan, Op. 20 (Kalmus A2119)**  
Beginning through 13 measures after Rehearsal **C**

### Orchestral Repertoire (2<sup>nd</sup> Violin parts):

- 6. Brahms: Piano Concerto No. 1 in D minor, Op. 15 (Breitkopf 2810)**  
Movement III: Measure 238 through m. 274 (Rehearsal **E** to 22 ms. Before reh. **E**<sup>1</sup>)
- \*7. Bruckner: Symphony No. 9 in D minor**  
Movement III: Measure 57 (reh. **D**) through m. 64)
- \*8. Mahler: Symphony No. 9 in D Major**  
Movement IV: Measure 49 through m. 82
- 9. Rachmaninoff: Symphony No. 2 in E minor, Op. 27 (Kalmus A 1901)**  
Movement II: Fifteen after Rehearsal **175** through four measures before Rehearsal **245** (top line divisi)  
(Measure 189 through m. 241)
- \*10. Bacewicz: Overture**  
Five measures before Rehearsal **13** to downbeat of five measures before reh. **18**
